

Application Guidelines

Applicants must submit a neatly typed essay of at least 500 words on one of the following topics:

- (1) *How my Christian Principals helped me continue to achieve during the Covid Pandemic*
- (2) *How the Fruits of the Spirit can be an active part of my College Life.*

Applicants must provide a sealed copy of their most recent transcript including SAT or ACT scores.

Applicants must submit three (3) letters of reference from individuals who can attest to their academics, character and community service (One from a high school teacher or administrator, one from a community leader, and one from a church member).

Each applicant must be an active member of Calvary Baptist Church for one (1) year and currently participating in the Calvary Baptist Youth Church and/or a church auxiliary. A resume must be submitted.

Applicants must submit verification of acceptance by the college or technical school that he/she has applied to. Proof of enrollment will be required before funds will be disbursed.

Additional Requirements for the Elizabeth C. Teague Scholarship:

- Applicant must have achieved a grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or above.
- Applicant must attend Delaware State University the year of high school graduation.
- Applicant's parents must have been a member of Calvary Baptist Church for at least five (5) years and have made a recognizable commitment to the church

Applicants do not need to apply for a specific scholarship.

Bessie V. Avant Leadership Scholarship

Priority will be given to graduating seniors who share her love for education and/or the arts. Two (2) \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

Mrs. Elizabeth C. Teague was a committed and dedicated member of Calvary Baptist Church. Mrs. Teague sacrificed herself for Calvary Baptist Church and the surrounding community.

Mrs. Teague was a successful buyer and Deputy Chief Contracting Officer at Dover Air Force Base for many years.
